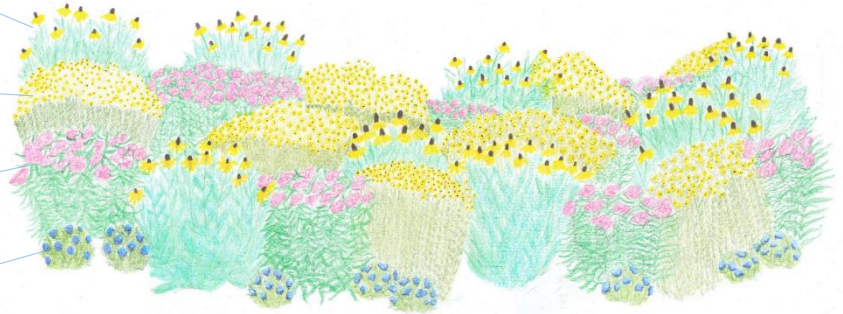


# Go BIG Mix

## Prairie Garden Plan

Create large-scale impact with this blend which includes three jumbo prairie perennials.

1. Large Coneflower x8  
(*Rudbeckia Maxima*)  
Mature size: 6'x4'
2. Tall Tickseed x8  
(*Coreopsis tripteris 'Gold Standard'*)  
Mature size: 6'x6'
3. Joe Pye Weed x8  
(*Eupatorium Gateway*)  
Mature size: 4.5'x3'
4. Blue Star x8  
(*Amsonia 'Blue Ice'*)  
Mature size: 2.5'x2'



**Description:** This mix includes BIG impact in a variety of tall-growing native OK prairie plants for an impressive display. Create a living fence with impressive swaths of flowers to enjoy along your property line, or back of the border for an extraordinary effect. Enjoy vibrant, heat-loving blooms during the dog days of summer when non-native perennials tend to decline. This mix plants roughly 100 sq. feet at maturity.

**Directions:** Plant in full sun (8+ hours direct sun) with moderate to well-drained soil. Water your plants regularly the first year in the ground. After the first year, water deeply once a week, or as needed. Once established, these tough plants will thrive in Oklahoma's brutal summer without the need of daily watering- an eco-friendly way to save money on your water bill. Prune late winter before new growth arrives in spring. Maximize your diversity of prairie plants with a complimentary blend such as Wild Mix.



1) Large Coneflower Vertical interest, capturing movement, wildlife forage/shelter, multi-season color interest, winter structure, naturalizes easily, drought tolerant. Zone 4-9.



2) Tall Tickseed Vertical interest, prolific bloomer, high-superior performance, pollinator-friendly, deer resistant, cut flowers heat/drought tolerant, clay tolerant, good for erosion control. Zone 4-9.

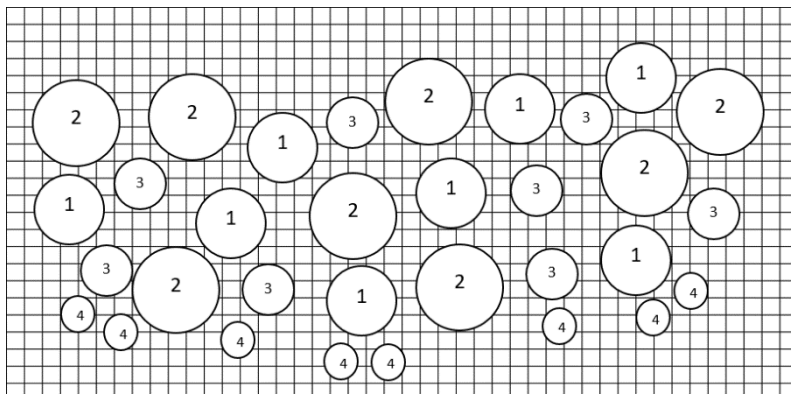


3) Joe Pye Weed Vertical interest, tidy and showy habit, striking deep pink flower clusters, road salt tolerant, pollinator-friendly, wet-feet tolerant, cut flowers, deer resistant,. Zone 4-8.



4) Blue Star Fall color display, disease-resistant, insect-resistant, erect & attractive habit, unique 5-petalied flowers, deer-resistant, wildlife forage/shelter, multi-season color interest, winter
